PALM BEACH SHOULDER & SPORTS MEDICINE FOUNDATION TO HOST CONFERENCE AT THE CONVENTION CENTER ON JUNE 6

WEST PALM BEACH, Fla. (May 27, 2009) — The Palm Beach Shoulder & Sports Medicine Foundation will host the “Palm Beach Shoulder Rehabilitation – State of the Art 2009” conference at the Palm Beach County Convention Center on Saturday, June 6 from 7:00 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. Designed for physical and occupational therapists, their assistants and athletic trainers, the conference will focus on the rehabilitation of many common and challenging shoulder pathologies and surgical procedures. Practical anatomy discussions and video demonstrations of surgical procedures will be included in the day-long event.

The schedule will also feature presentations by industry experts such as Howard D. Routman, D.O., F.A.O.A.O., director of Palm Beach Shoulder Service at Atlantis Orthopaedics and president of the Palm Beach Shoulder and Sports Medicine Foundation. Dr. Routman’s clinical practice specializes in the management of all aspects of conditions that affect the shoulder. His academic activities include research efforts that also focus on the shoulder. He has lectured locally, regionally and nationally on shoulder topics and has directed and participated in many didactic and practical courses to train orthopaedic surgeons in the methods for shoulder diagnosis and the techniques for non-operative and operative treatment. Dr. Routman’s current emphasis for surgical treatment is in minimally-invasive arthroscopic shoulder surgery techniques.

The cost of tuition for the conference is \$250. The coursework has been approved for nine hours of CEU credit by the Florida Physical Therapy Association and for nine and a half hours of CEU credit by the Florida Occupational Therapy Association.

Following the conference, there will be a two hour reception where attendees will have the opportunity to network with their local and regional colleagues and spend time with the faculty.
